appreciating life's simple moments.


School of Pharma




Kevin Bosnoyan – P4 Class Representative


Upon graduation, Aya aspires to establish her own pharmaceutical industry, focusing on innovation, quality, and accessibility in drug manufacturing.


Elie Germanos – P2 Class Representative
