

Bachelor of Science in Pharmacy Student Outreach Award

To be awarded annually at the Hooding Ceremony

Deadline for receipt of nominations: End of June

Description

The Bachelor of Science (B.S.) Student Outreach Award is presented annually by the Lebanese American University School of Pharmacy to a graduating student with the degree of B.S. in Pharmacy. The award is presented in a form of a recognition plaque.

Objective

The B.S. Student Outreach Award recognizes a graduating student who has led or been extensively involved in community engagement activities, projects, or programs that promote pharmacy awareness, outreach services and improve public health.

Eligibility and Qualifications

In order to be considered for the award, the nominee must:

- 1. Be a current B.S. graduating student at the Lebanese American University School of Pharmacy.
- 2. Be nominated by a current faculty member.
- 3. Not have any disciplinary action on his/her permanent student record during their years of study at the Lebanese American University School of Pharmacy.
- 4. Meet a combination of the following professional and personal qualifications, but not necessarily in all categories:

Demonstrates civic involvement, enthusiasm, and commitment to the welfare of others.
Is actively involved in professional organizations at the local and national levels.
Actively participates in the planning and coordination of the activities of the School
pharmacy students' society (e.g., No Apathy Pharmacy and Health Awareness Student
Society-NAPHASS) and/or any School and University community outreach activities.
Provides informational and educational presentations to healthcare professionals and
the general public on pharmacy- and public health- related issues.
Engages in providing patient care and/or public health services to the general public,
especially to underserved population or disaster areas.
Participates in interprofessional education and practice activities.
Maintains high professional, ethical, and moral standards.

Nomination Process

- 1. Current full time faculty can nominate one graduating B.S. student per academic year for the award.
- 2. The faculty should also provide a checklist of the professional and personal qualifications of the student as per #3 above, along with any other supportive evidence or information deemed necessary for the nomination.
- 3. All nominations and supportive information must be submitted confidentially to the Assistant Dean for Student Affairs.

Selection Process

All nominations will be reviewed by the School Events Committee. One student will be selected to receive the award. The Assistant Dean for Student Affairs will submit the committee's decision to the School Academic Council for review and final approval. The decision of the School Academic Council is final.
