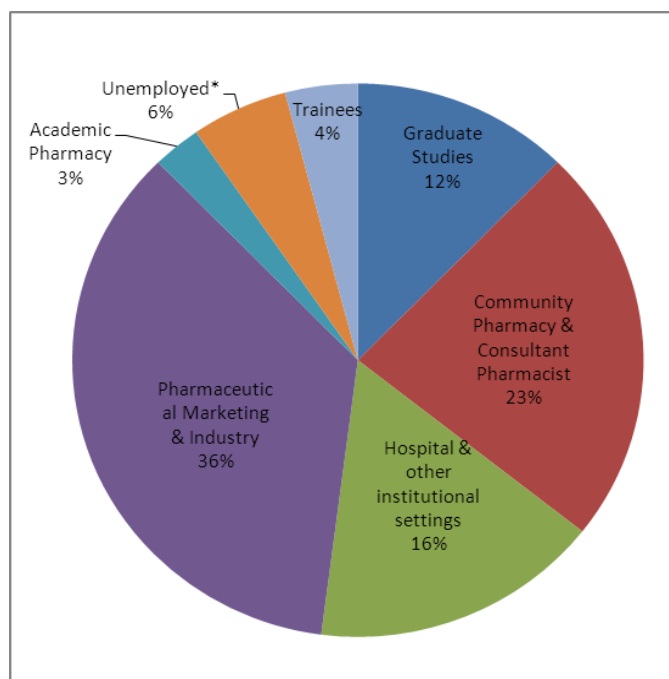


Doctor of Pharmacy Graduates Career Pursuit First Year Following Graduation
